TRIP ITINERARY

DAY 1 - 3/22
Los Angeles/
Beijing

Board a convenient charter bus one night before the departure day (March 21), and travel to Los Angeles International Airport for an early morning flight CA984 at 1:40am to Beijing. Your adventure begins as you fly trans-Pacific aboard a wide cabin jetliner and cross the International Dateline.

DAY 2 - 3/23
Beijing

Stay at Telecom Hotel/5-Star, 6 Shifangyuan Ave., Tel: 86-10-63901166
Arrive in Beijing, the Capital of China at 6:30am. You will be met by your local tour guide at the airport and transfer to your hotel. The first attraction will be a visit to **Tian An Men Square**, the largest square in the world, and the **Temple of Heaven**, built in 1420 A.D., where emperors pray for a good harvest.

DAY 3 - 3/24
Beijing

Sightseeing includes the **Palace Museum**, also known as the **Forbidden City**, home of 24 emperors with a total space of 9,999 rooms, and the **Summer Palace**, known for many significance such as the Long Corridor with painted gallery, Kunming Lake and Longevity Hill, Seventeen- Arch Bridge and Marble Boat.

Tour bus excursion to the **Great Wall**, the 4,000-mile long and 2,000 years old construction is said to be the only man-made structure visible by naked eye from the moon. Visit to the **Ming Tombs**, one of 13 Ming Emperors' Tombs is fully excavated and open for exploration. Enjoy a traditional **Beijing Duck Dinner**.

Visit to the **National Embroidery Institute** to see silk embroidery, an important local craft with 1,000 years of history. Experience an **Evening Dinner Show** with traditional Chinese Music.

Stay at the Howard Johnson Hotel/5-Star, 288 Genshan West Rd., Tel: 86-571-86767888
Morning tour bus journey to **Hangzhou**. Visit the **Economic Development Zone** and the centuries old **Lingyin Temple**, with the main feature of the 64.3 ft-high camphor-wood carved Buddha.

Morning **boat cruise** on West Lake with relaxing stopover at jewel-like pagodas and tea houses. Afternoon tour bus trip to **Shanghai**.

Sightseeing includes the **Yu Garden**, a maze of marvelous pavilions, ponds, rocky works and over arching trees. Visit to the **Bund**, a famous waterfront park. Take a business visit to the **Pudong Economic Development Zone**.

MORE INFORMATION

The trip price of \$1999 per person is based on double occupancy. A single room in all cities will cost an additional \$450. A business class upgrade on the round-trip flight is \$4500.

REGISTRATION: A \$200 non-refundable deposit is required for each traveler at the time of registration and full payment is due by December 15, 2009.

TRAVEL REQUIREMENTS: A passport and a Chinese travel visa are required for all travelers. Visa application assistance is available for a fee of \$145 from the Goleta Valley Chamber of Commerce (request for assistance must be submitted by 12/15/09).

TRAVEL INSURANCE: The airline imposes a \$500 ticket cancellation fee. We strongly encourage you to purchase travel insurance in the event you must cancel. (If you don't have this insurance, you will be responsible for the \$500 fee.)
